STAFF REPORT

City Planning Director Angie Byington reported that she and her staff were working on the East Bay Plan to increase public access. The application for a matching grant for \$90,000 was submitted to ODNR with the City pledging \$45,000. We should hear back on the application this month and if awarded work would begin in July. The pavilion was included in the grant application.

According to Director Brad Link the Sandusky Pathway Node is on the list for work to be done. NO discussion about the Apex property. Mr. Schwanger inquired about security cameras at the pavilion property due to increasing graffiti. Ms. Byington will check on a camera.

Mr. Miller inquired about the Steering Committee meeting for the Bicentennial Commission meeting that was held at the Small City Tap House. Ms. Byington explained that meeting was for steering Committee for the Comprehensive Plan and the 5-10 year Strategic Plan, that will coincide with the bicentennial but is not to be confused with the actual Bicentennial Commission headed by Dr. Semans. Dr. Semans reported on the progress on the planning for 200 events during 2018 around a Spring, Summer and Fall themed events, including a visit from the Tall Ships.
