THE RED POPCORN WAGON

Columbus Avenue at Washington Park

The Red Wagon has been a fixture in Washington Park since the year 1910 and is listed in the National Register of Historic Places by the National Park Service. Over the years, the wagon was owned and operated by numerous families.



In 2002, the wagon was donated to the City of Sandusky by Mr. and Mrs. Jack Colvin. After receiving over \$25,000 in local grant funds, the wagon underwent a complete restoration at the Wyandot Popcorn Museum in Marion, Ohio.

As part of the City of Sandusky's annual Stars and Stripes Celebration in 2003, the newly-restored Red Wagon was officially presented to the community with a ribbon cutting ceremony.

Throughout the summer, members of the United Way



of Erie County staff the wagon Monday through Saturday each week between 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. Volunteers pop and sell fresh popcorn keeping 80% of the proceeds for their respective agency and donating 20% to the endowment.

The Red Popcorn Wagon is open from Memorial Day to Labor Day.
