The Schade-Mylander Plaza was dedicated by George L. Mylander in 2000 in memory of his parents and grandparents, Lester & Christine Mylander and George & Anna Schade.

Schade-Mylander Plaza serves as a gathering place for families and friends. The plaza is a popular spot for wedding photos, and even wedding ceremonies occasionally take place at this picturesque plaza.



More than 3.5 million people travel to the north shore to experience the thrill and excitement of the Cedar Point Amusement Park. Cedar Point is located on a peninsula between Sandusky Bay and Lake Erie and provides great views of both waterfront features.

Directions:

From East: Enter town via Cleveland Rd. (Rt. 6). Follow Cleveland Rd. to Warren St. Take Warren St. to Monroe St. and turn left. Then turn right on Columbus Ave. Plaza at end of street.

From West: Enter town via Tiffin Ave. (101 or Rt. 6) Continue on Tiffin which will turn into Washington St. Then turn left onto Columbus Ave. Plaza at the end of street.

From South: Enter town via Milan Rd. (US 250). Take Milan Rd. to Monroe St. and turn left. Follow Monroe St. to Columbus Ave. and turn right. Schade-Mylander Plaza is at the end of street.
