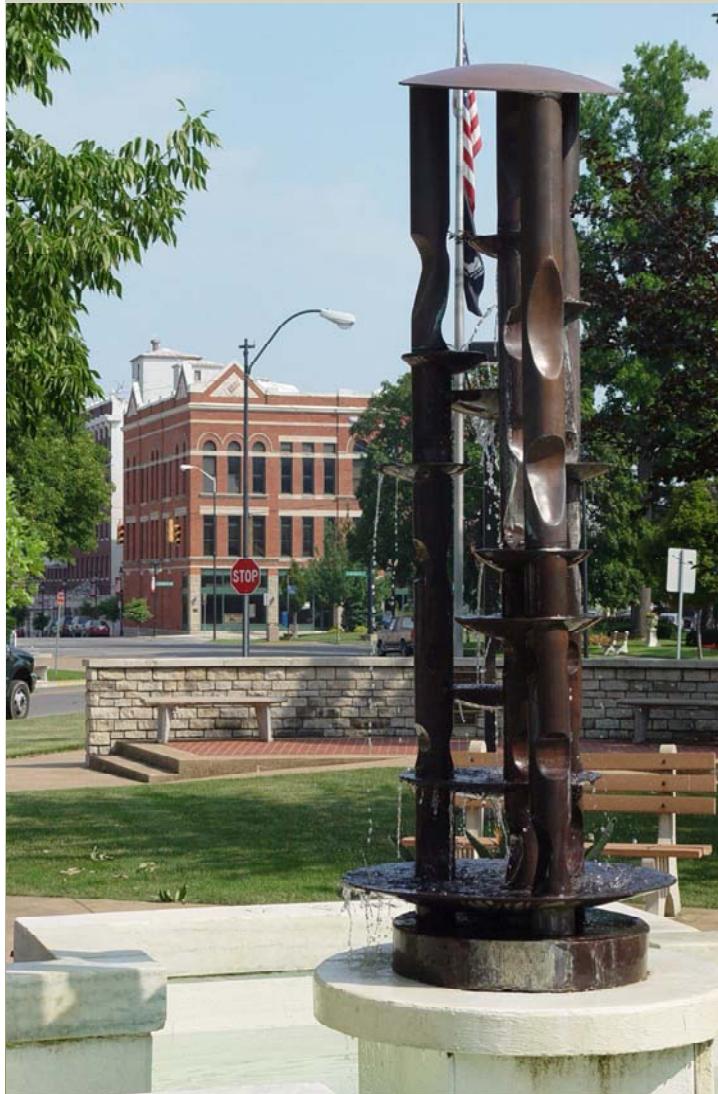

VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK

Washington Street at Washington Park

A visit to the Washington Park complex would not be complete without spending a few minutes in the Erie County Veterans Memorial Park.

Located just west of the Erie County Courthouse, the park is dedicated to all Erie County veterans,

particularly those who lost their lives in service to their country.



On a pentagonal monument are plaques with the names of over 300 men from Erie County who have lost their lives starting with the Civil War. Other memorials salute veterans from the various conflicts which have been fought since that time. Services in the park area are conducted by the Park Committee on the Sunday before Memorial Day and on Veteran's Day each year.

Dedicated in 1986, after an countywide fundraising campaign, the park has been developed in phases and is visited by hundreds of people each year.

A beautiful fountain is centered in the park and honors those who fought in the Spanish-American War. Over 100 years old, it was relocated to the park after its inception and dedication.



In 2006, the Korean Veterans Association added a monument to Veterans Park in honor of the men and women that served the United States during the Korean War.
